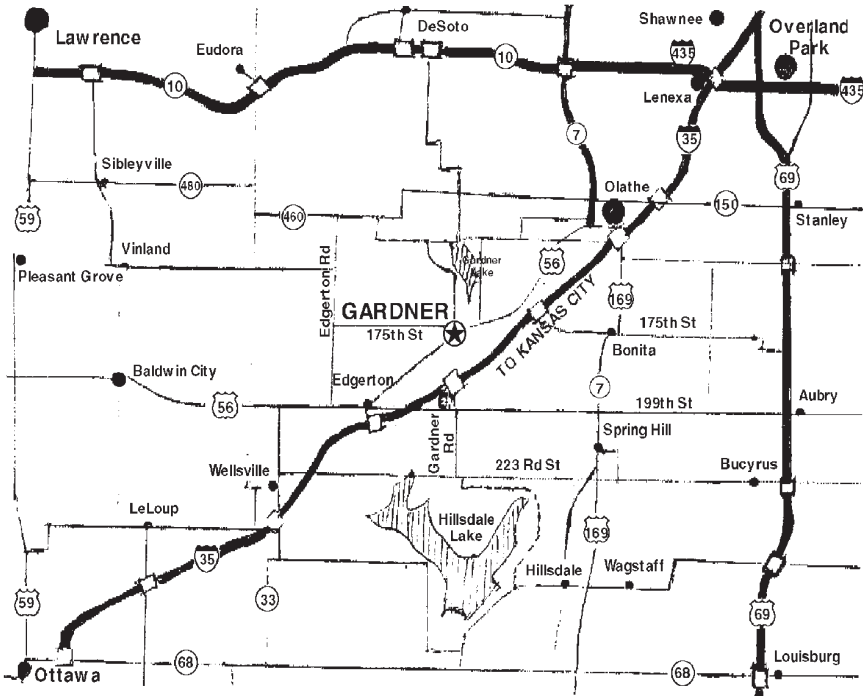

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present in the Novice Class.

ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors at 5:00 pm Thursday, May 19, 2011. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on Sunday, May 22, 2011.

1. No dogs are to be allowed in the 4-H, Flower or Food Stand Buildings.
2. You must clean up after your dogs.
3. Cereal Malt beverages, alcoholic beverages and narcotics of any kind ARE NOT allowed on the Fairgrounds.
4. The parking lot at the Elm & Washington entrance is reserved for judges and the handicapped. The Center Street & Madison Street entrance is for exhibitors.
5. No dogs will be allowed in restrooms or in the shower facilities. Wash areas are available. Crating will not be allowed in the conformation or obedience buildings. Crating will be available at ringside for toy breeds while being judged. Dogs must be removed immediately upon completion of judging.
6. Watch your dogs and do not let them urinate on inside walls, to help eliminate odors and cleanup problems. Please keep your grooming area clean.
7. Videotaping by individuals for their own personal use will be allowed, but the Show Committee reserves the right to regulate the placement of cameras. Unauthorized commercial photographers will not be allowed.
8. Trophies must be claimed the day of the show.
9. Exhibitor Parking will be on a first come, first parked basis.

(American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**
